NEAS Visit in MaanJee School

Mr. Amjad Hussain along with the members of NEAS (National Education Assessment System) visited MaanJee School in Pakistan at national level with the cooperation of provincial and area Assessment Centers. NEAS was established as five years' development project with the financial assistance of the World Bank and department for international Development significance in the education system. Now NEAS is a sub-ordinate office under Ministry of Federal Education and professional Training. They visited MaanJee School to assess any twenty students from grade 5, the subjects they selected were Math and Urdu for assessment. As per the schedule, tests were held on 23rd October 2017 on Monday (Math's) and 24th October 2017 on Tuesday (Urdu). All the enrolled students presented in class but the selected only twenty students out of forty-seven. It was observed that all the students were comfortable and seemed well prepared for assessment .



The Purpose of Assessment

- * To identify the extent to which geography and gender are linked to inequality in student performance.
- * NEAS monitoring how well the curricula are translated into knowledge and skills.
- * NEAS identifying correlates of Achievements the principle determinants of student's performance.
- * Teacher's efforts and raising students and use data to improve student performance.
