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MONTESSORI & PRIMARY SCHOOL TEACHER TRAINING:

What do I need to do to become a primary school teacher?

To teach in a Maanjee school, there are a number of routes you can take to become a primary school teacher.

You could follow an undergraduate Initial Teacher Education or Training programme, such as a Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) and Montessori training.

Alternatively, you could do a degree – this could be in a subject you wish to specialize in like Maths, science, or English – then take a postgraduate teacher training programme.

.Training a teacher is preparing them to carry out his/her educational functions very effectively, and to achieve such event depends on the ability of the teacher to give, and create and interact, and mastering sciences and the application of the different methods of teaching according to each learning situation, and it happens when the teacher manages his class firmly and successfully, and this management relies also on the teacher's personality and his style in dealing with students inside and outside the classroom, so all real educational reform must be based on the teacher training.

Pre-Primary and primary teachers are taking Montessori Training classes in MaanJee Welfare Secondary School from “Pakistan Montessori International” (PMI). Syed Naseem (TRAINER) conducted eight classes after summer vacations Syed Naseem will conduct remaining classes. The whole Montessori course will have conducted ten classes, school provides material for project. It is a certificate course sixteen teachers are engaged in this training.

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PRACTICAL EXAMINATION 2018:



Circular dispatched to all schools includes instructions to conduct practical examination. While the time period is designated by the Secondary board of education, the actual dates for the practical exam are decided by the individual schools.

A group-based laboratory practical exam for school. Students move individually through three groups meant to authentically assess both basic lab skills and problem-solving skills utilized throughout the year. The exam can be completed in an approximately 85 min lab period and can be easily adapted to assess other skills.

Teachers Ms. Kiran Ali and Ms.Saima Sultana took Chemistry and Physics practical while Ms.Kiran Ali took computer practical. It will be finished in time. All practicals Exam have Invigilated through the principal . Seema Asif will be invigilating over the final practical Examinations to ensure that the students do not cheat.

Practical examination is not a new component in class X but schools do not want to leave anything to chance to help students score maximum marks. Once the practical examination concludes schools gear up for one more round of revision exams for the Board theory papers.
